Overseas exiles may apply for ONE ticket for each **HUT** held at St Leonards on Thursday, 7th June at 6.00 a.m. and Friday, 8th June at 9.00 a.m. Once again a limited number are reserved for returned Teries. ***A strict dress code of collar tie for Gentlemen, or equivalent for Ladies, must be observed.***
